



EXECUTIVE ORDER NO. 54

Series of 2020

AN EXECUTIVE ORDER DECLARING THE ESTABLISHMENT/INSTITUTION IDENTIFIED BY THE CITY HEALTH OFFICE WITH OFFICES LOCATED IN NATIONAL HIGHWAY, BARANGAY KALANDAGAN AND NATIONAL HIGHWAY, BARANGAY POBLACION, CITY OF TACURONG AS CRITICAL ZONES AS PER ZONING CONTAINMENT STRATEGY.

WHEREAS, a report from the City Health Office and the PNP Station Tacurong City was received with the information that eight employees of an institution/establishment located in National Highway, Barangay Kalandagan, City of Tacurong was found to be Positive for COVID 19 as a result of the RT PCR test and some of their employees coming from their Office located in National Highway, Poblacion, City of Tacurong were also swabbed/tested and considered suspects for COVID 19.

WHEREAS, pursuant to DILG Regional Memorandum Order No. 2020-14 and stipulated under Executive Order No. 112 and NTF Memorandum Circular No.2 there is a need to implement a localized lockdown and strategically contain the spread or transmission of the said virus;

WHEREAS, Executive Order 58, Series of 2020 of the Province of Sultan Kudarat Section 33 thereof, the Local Chief Executive is given the authority to declare granular lockdown to prevent and impede the spread or contamination thereof;

NOW, THEREFORE, I ANGELO O. MONTILLA, by the powers vested in me by law as the City Mayor of Tacurong City do hereby Order the following:

SECTION 1. TEMPORARY CLOSURE OF IDENTIFIED ESTABLISHMENT/INSTITUTION. The subject establishment/institution identified by the City Health Office located in National highway, Poblacion, City of Tacurong shall be temporarily closed to the public for 7 days or from December 27, 2020 to January 2, 2021 for disinfection purposes while the identified establishment/institution located in National Highway, Barangay Kalandagan, City of Tacurong shall be temporarily closed to the public for 14 days or from December 27, 2020 to January 9, 2021.

SECTION 2. CONDUCT OF CASE INVESTIGATION. BHERTS are instructed to conduct case investigation within 24 hours and conduct contact tracing of all close/direct contacts of confirmed COVID 19 cases.

SECTION 3. DAILY REPORT OF CESU OFFICER. The City Epidemiology Surveillance Unit (CESU) Officer shall render a daily report inclosing his monitoring and evaluation of the status of the spread or contamination of the Corona Virus in the area, for its submission thereafter to the DILG Regional Director/RIATF 12 Chairperson.

SECTION 4. INSTITUTION/ESTABLISHMENT ACTION PLAN BEFORE RE-OPENING. The management of the institution/establishment identified by the City Health Office shall present an Action Plan relative to

the safety of personnel, preparedness, mitigation, response, and contingency plan to COVID 19 to the Office of the City Mayor and Incident Management Team for COVID 19 before its reopening.

SECTION 5. PENAL CLAUSE. Those found resisting and seriously disobeying any person in authority or his agents while engaged in enforcing this Order will be penalized in accordance with Article 151 of the Revised Penal Code.

SECTION 6. EFFECTIVITY. This Order shall take effect immediately and shall remain effective until January 2, 2021 and January 9, 2021 respectively, unless sooner revoked, modified or repealed accordingly.

Let a copy of this Executive Order with Data Analytics and Action Plan including the report of the City Health Officer and PNP Station of Tacurong be submitted to RIATF – EID Region 12 in compliance with DILG Region 12 Advisory dated August 24, 2020 for concurrence purposes and copy furnished the DILG Provincial Director of the Province of Sultan Kudarat and Office of the Provincial Governor of the Province of Sultan Kudarat.
