



EXECUTIVE ORDER NO. 20

Series of 2020

THIS IS AN ORDER DECLARING THE ENTIRE AREA OF TACURONG CITY UNDER GENERAL COMMUNITY QUARANTINE AND PROVIDING GUIDELINES FOR COMPLIANCE THEREOF

WHEREAS, President Rodrigo Roa Duterte through Presidential Proclamation No. 922, had declared a State of Public Health Emergency throughout the entire country due to the outbreak of coronavirus (COVID-19);

WHEREAS, the President had likewise issued Presidential Proclamation No. 929 declaring a State of Calamity in the Philippines due to the spread of coronavirus disease or COVID-19;

WHEREAS, other places in Mindanao have already reported positive cases of coronaviruses (COVID-19);

WHEREAS, to protect and preempt the contamination of said virus of the residents of Tacurong City, necessary and appropriate preventive measures should be adopted and implemented;

NOW THEREFORE, I, ANGELO O. MONTILLA, as the City Mayor of Tacurong City, by the powers vested in me by law, do hereby order the placing of the entire area of jurisdiction of Tacurong City under General Community Quarantine and for the observance and compliance of the following guidelines:

a. The restriction of the non-essential/non-residents entry of people to Tacurong City especially of persons who are at risk of being infected, i.e., those 60 years old and above, those who are immunocompromised (having weak immune system) or with comorbidities (having one or more diseases or conditions that occur along with another condition in the same person at the same time), and pregnant women, except:

- i. Health workers;
- ii. Authorized government officials;
- iii. Those travelling for medical or humanitarian reasons;
- iv. Persons transiting to airport for travel abroad;
- v. Persons providing basic services and public utilities;
- vi. Essential skeletal workforce

b. The prevention of the non-essential exit of people out of Tacurong City area, except;

- i. Health workers;
- ii. Authorized government officials;
- iii. Those travelling for medical or humanitarian reasons;
- iv. Those who were granted entry based on the above-mentioned provisions.

All persons leaving Tacurong City must be checked for signs and symptoms (e.g., fever, respiratory symptoms, and diarrhea) at exit checkpoints, where:
