



EXECUTIVE ORDER NO. 30
Series of 2021

AN EXECUTIVE ORDER DECLARING THE EXECUTIVE AND LEGISLATIVE OFFICES OF THE LOCAL GOVERNMENT UNIT (LGU) OF THE CITY OF TACURONG AS CRITICAL ZONE (ECQ) AS PER ZONING CONTAINMENT STRATEGY FROM JUNE 7 TO 13, 2021.

WHEREAS, a report from the City Health Office was received with the information that five employees of the local government unit was found to be Positive for COVID 19 as a result of the RT PCR test.

WHEREAS, the LGU officials, employees and the general public are in grief due to the untimely demise of Mayor Angelo O. Montilla last June 6, 2021 whose COVID RT PCR Test yielded Positive result.

WHEREAS, a recommendation from Incident Management Team was also received to temporary close all offices of the local government unit of Tacurong as a "circuit breaker" to strategically contain the spread or transmission of corona virus among employees and their customers and facilitate the smooth succession of authority.

WHEREAS, due to the exigency of services, the following offices shall be exempted: Office for Health Services, City Disaster Risk Reduction Management Office, Economic Enterprise Management Section and Civil Security Unit of the Office of the City Mayor, Office for Environment and Natural Resources and other instrumentalities of the Incident Management Team (IMT) such as Transportation Group composed of Drivers, Supply Unit and Food Unit, and Task Force for the Management of LSI/ROF/Travelers.

WHEREAS, pursuant to DILG Regional Memorandum Order No. 2020-14 and stipulated under Executive Order No. 112 and NTF Memorandum Circular No.2 there is a need to implement a localized lockdown and strategically contain the spread or transmission of the said virus;

WHEREAS, Executive Order 15, Series of 2021 of the Province of Sultan Kudarat Section 2, item y thereof, the Local Chief Executive is given the authority to declare granular lockdown to prevent and impede the spread or contamination thereof;

NOW, THEREFORE, I LINO O. MONTILLA, by the powers vested in me by law as the new City Mayor of Tacurong City do hereby Order the following:

SECTION 1. TEMPORARY CLOSURE OF EXECUTIVE AND LEGISLATIVE OFFICES OF THE LOCAL GOVERNMENT UNIT OF THE CITY OF TACURONG . Offices under Executive and Legislatives branches of the LGU shall be temporarily close to the public for 7 days or from June 7 to 13, 2021.

SECTION 2. EXCEMPTED OFFICES. Due to the exigency of services, the following offices shall be exempted: Office for Health Services, City Disaster Risk Reduction Management Office, Economic Enterprise Management Section and Civil Security Unit including CCTV operators of the Office of the City Mayor, Office for Environment and Natural Resources and other instrumentalities of the Incident Management Team (IMT) such as Transportation Group composed of Drivers, Supply Unit, Food Unit, Facilities Unit, Ground Support Unit, Medical Group, Sanitation Group, and Task Force for the Management of LSI/ROF/Travelers.

SECTION 3. OFFICES WITH INDISPENSABLE SERVICES. The Head of Offices with indispensable functions such as collection of fines, and the like, and those related to COVID operations are directed to formulate strategies and assign personnel to perform such functions.

SECTION 4. PUBLIC INFORMATION. All Head of Offices shall provide hotline numbers for customers to call upon on their needed services. The Information Officer shall gather this hotline numbers and disseminate to the public.

All closed offices are required to post a signage of their hotline numbers in their entrance office doors for the customers to call to and assign personnel to answer queries.

SECTION 5. CONDUCT OF CASE INVESTIGATION. The City Epidemiology Surveillance Unit (CESU) are instructed to conduct case investigation within 24 hours and conduct contact tracing of all close/direct contacts of confirmed COVID 19 cases.

SECTION 6. DAILY REPORT OF CESU OFFICER. The City Epidemiology Surveillance Unit (CESU) Officer shall render a daily report inclosing his monitoring and evaluation of the status of the spread or contamination of the Corona Virus in the area, for its submission thereafter to the DILG Regional Director/RIATF 12 Chairperson.

SECTION 7. PENAL CLAUSE. Those found resisting and seriously disobeying any person in authority or his agents while engaged in enforcing this Order will be penalized in accordance with Article 151 of the Revised Penal Code.

SECTION 8. EFFECTIVITY. This Order shall take effect immediately and shall remain effective until June 13, 2021 unless sooner revoked, modified or repealed accordingly

Let a copy of this Executive Order with Data Analytics and Action Plan including the report of the City Health Officer and PNP Station of Tacurong be submitted to RIATF – EID Region 12 in compliance with DILG Region 12 Advisory dated August 24, 2020 for concurrence purposes and copy furnished the DILG Provincial Director of the Province of Sultan Kudarat and Office of the Provincial Governor of the Province of Sultan Kudarat.
