ORDINANCE NO. 075-2021

“AN ORDINANCE ADOPTING THE REVISED POLICIES AND REGULATIONS ON IRRIGATION FACILITIES IN THE CITY OF TACURONG, ADOPTING FOR THE PURPOSE A CROPPING CALENDAR AND PROVIDING PENALTIES FOR VIOLATION THEREOF.”

EXPLANATORY NOTE

Republic Act No. 7160, otherwise known as the *Local Government Code of 1991*, particularly Section 16 of the *General Welfare Clause*, provides among others, that “[e]very local government unit shall exercise the powers expressly granted, those necessarily implied therefrom, as well as powers necessary, appropriate, or incidental for its efficient and effective governance, and those which are essential to the promotion of the general welfare.”

Likewise, Section 17 mandates local governments to provide basic services and facilities, particularly “[e]xtension and on-site research services and facilities related to agriculture and fishery activities which include xxx inter-barangay irrigation system; water and soil resource utilization and conservation projects xxx.

In line with these provisions, the City Government of Tacurong enacted Ordinance No. 04, series of 2013, which adopts the Policies and Regulations ensuring the smooth operation of the Irrigation Facilities in the City and provides penalties for its violation. The Ordinance specifically designed policies and measures that can help the farmers including a cropping calendar, equitable distribution of irrigation water and protection and maintenance of irrigation canals and facilities.
