ORDINANCE NO. 079-2021

“AN ORDINANCE PROVIDING FOR THE SPEED LIMITS FOR ALL KINDS OF MOTOR VEHICLES WITHIN THE TERRITORIAL JURISDICTION OF THE CITY OF TACURONG, PROVIDING PENALTIES FOR VIOLATION THEREOF, COLLECTION OF ROAD CRASH DATA, AND APPROPRIATING FUNDS FOR THIS PURPOSE.”

EXPLANATORY NOTE

The World Health Organization (WHO) estimated that 1.3 million people dies and over 50 million are getting injured in road crashes across the world annually. Subsequently, 93% of the world's fatalities on the roads occur in low- and middle-income countries, even though these countries have approximately 60% of the world's vehicles. It also reported that road traffic injuries are the leading cause of death for children and young adults aged 5-29 years.

On 2011, the Department of Transportation (DOTr) formulated the Philippine Road Safety Action Plan (PRSAP) 2011-2020, with the goal of reducing the number of road traffic accident rate in the country by 50% in 2020. Moreover, the PRSAO aims to improve road safety management, safer road, safer vehicles, safer road users, thus preventing road accidents and deaths.
